- **Send your UNFI order to Sue Kataja at [BFC UNFI@yahoo.com](mailto:BFC_UNFI@yahoo.com)** You'll need to download the Foodlink software from the BFC website <http://www.brightonfoodcoop.org/> and Sue will soon be sending out the necessary files for you to import into Foodlink with your Member ID and the updated price list. If you have any technical Foodlink questions, you can email Sue at [susanjkataja@hotmail.com](mailto:susanjkataja@hotmail.com)
- **Send your FRONTIER order to Diane Brady at [dbramblewood@sbcglobal.net](mailto:dbramblewood@sbcglobal.net)** No special form needed; just be sure to include the page#, item#, product name, size (if applicable) and quantity needed of each item you are ordering, in the body of your email.
- **Send your Outside Vendor orders (Zingerman's, Rosewood, Almar, Motave, Besteman's, Nuts/Honey/Syrup, Specialty) to Kris Verschoor at [kverschoor@sbcglobal.net](mailto:kverschoor@sbcglobal.net)** Again, no special form needed; just include the vendor name, item#, product name, size (if applicable) and quantity needed of each item you are ordering in the body of your email. It's also helpful if you can indicate whether you'd be willing to take more of something...for example, you want 3 pounds of cheddar cheese from Rosewood, but you'd take 4 or 5 pounds if you had to.

That's all for now...don't forget to send me any changes in your address/phone#/email address so I can pass them along to Jim Brown, our communications dude...he should be sending out an updated membership list soon, so be on the lookout for that, too.
