### **Chocolate Candy Recipe (11-21-18)**

4 oz. unsweetened baking chocolate, melt first

1 oz. cocoa butter (15 to 16 buttons) – do not let this get too warm, just enough to melt!!

4 T. powdered sweetener (e.g. THM Gentle Sweet or 3 to 4 T. Pyure, ground up)

1/8 teas. Stevia powder

Melt chocolate first, then add the next 3 ingredients and melt together in a pot in a water bath on the stove.

Remove from heat and stir in the last 2 ingredients:

½ teas. vanilla extract

¼ teas. salt

Pour into molds and refrigerate. Makes about 46 kisses (in kiss or large chocolate chip molds)
